- Yukon Parkway & Main; flashing yellow arrow- all 4 directions. Main St. is 50 mph; it is recommended you don't allow permissive left turns.
- South Bound Hwy 4; 3 signals green, one at right turn bay. Left arrow out of High School to stay green to keep going.
- Outlay of sidewalk from Ranchwood to shopping area; might want to extend to 10th, further South.
