INSTRUCTIONS

Who shall file a Notice of Intent Form

Under the provisions of the Clean Water Act, Oklahoma Environmental Code, Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-14-101 and the rules of OAC 252:002.15, discharge of stormwater from construction activities is prohibited without an Oklahoma Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit. The operator of a construction site that has such a storm water discharge must submit a NOI to obtain coverage under an OPDES Storm Water General Permit.

Section I: Facility Owner/Operator information

Provide the legal name, mailing address, and telephone number of the person, firm, public organization, or any other entity that either individually or together meet the following two criteria: (1) have operational control over the site specifications (including the ability to make modifications in specifications); and (2) have the day-to-day operational control of those activities at the site necessary to ensure compliance with plan requirements and permit conditions.

Section II: Facility Site Information

Enter the Project's official or legal name and complete street address, including city, county, state, ZIP code and phone number. The applicant must also provide the latitude and longitude of the facility in decimal degrees.

Provide the area of the total site and the area of the estimated disturbed area to the nearest acre. Provide your DEQ authorization if the site is an acre or more or part of a common plan of development. Enter the address, website, or email address to access the SWP3.

Enter the name of the receiving waterbody. If no waterbody exists on site, then enter the name of the closest receiving waterbody. This information can be found on DEQ's Data Viewer: https://gis.deq.ok.gov/maps/?page=page_0

Section III: Certification

Federal regulations require all permit applications to be signed as follows: **For a corporation:** by a responsible corporate officer, which means: (i) a president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision making functions for the corporation, or (ii) the manager of one or more manufacturing, production, or operating facilities, provided, the manager is authorized to make management decisions which govern the operation of the regulated facility including having the explicit or implicit duty of making major capital investment recommendations, and initiating and directing other comprehensive measures to assure long term environmental compliance with environmental law and regulations; the manager can ensure that the necessary systems are established or actions taken to gather complete and accurate information for permit application requirements; and where authority to sign documents had been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures; **For a limited liability company (LLC):** by a member, managing or otherwise; **For a partnership:** by a general partner; **For a sole proprietorship:** by the proprietor (owner); or **For a municipality, state, federal, or other public facility:** by either a principal executive or ranking elected official.
